BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty,
by and with the advice and consent of the Legis-
lative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South
Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of
the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the "Totalizator Short title.
(Amendment) Act, 1919," and shall be read with the
Totalizator Act, 1916, hereinafter called the Principal
Act.

(1) Section two:—

The following definition is inserted next after the definition of “Inspector”:—

“Minister” means Colonial Secretary.

The definition of “Racing Club” is amended by the addition of the words “and includes the trustees of any ground on which such racing is held.”

(2) Section three:—

(a) In the first paragraph after “race meetings” insert “or on any enclosure in any such racecourse.”

(b) In the first paragraph after the words “meeting is held” insert the words “by such or any other club.”

Sec. 4.

(3) Section four:—

Omit the section, insert in lieu thereof:

4. Before any totalizator is established, the totalizator and the proposed site thereof shall be approved by the Minister.

Such approval may be subject to such conditions as the Minister may think fit.

(a) In subsection two omit the first paragraph and insert the following in lieu thereof:—

“Every such club shall, within fourteen days after the holding of any race-meeting, if a club specified in Part I of the Schedule hereto, pay seven-tenths, and if a club specified in Part II of such Schedule, five-tenths of the amount so deducted to the Colonial Treasurer, or some person appointed by him, to be paid by him into the Treasury and carried to the Consolidated Revenue Fund. Any such amount may be recovered from such club as a Crown debt in any court of competent jurisdiction.”
