GEORGI V REGIS.

Act No. 47, 1918.

An Act to amend the Truck Act of 1900 and the Truck Act Amendment Act of 1901. [Assented to, 19th December, 1918.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the “Truck (Amend- Short title. ment) Act, 1918.”

2. Section ten of the Truck Act of 1900, as amended Amendment of s. 10 of the Truck Act of 1900. by the Truck Act Amendment Act of 1901, is amended by omitting the words “within the county of Yanco-winna” and by adding at the end of the section the words “or to a medical guarantee fund.”

REGISTRATION ACT

IN RELATION TO THE REGISTRATION OF LAND

1918

Enacted by the Parliament of New South Wales
in the 23rd year of His Majesty King George V.

Section 1. In this Act, unless the context otherwise requires, the following definitions apply:—

(1) "Land" means any land, whether or not it is a fee simple estate, and includes any right or interest in land, but does not include any right or interest in land which is a lease for a term not exceeding three years.

(2) "Registered land" means land which is registered in the Register of Land, and includes any right or interest in such land, but does not include any right or interest in land which is a lease for a term not exceeding three years.

I certify that this PUBLIC BILL, which originated in the LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY, has finally passed the LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL and the LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY of NEW SOUTH WALES.
