## A BILL

To enable the executive committee of the Citizens' War Chest to make payments out of the Citizens' War Chest Fund to and for charitable purposes.

**W**HEREAS there is under the control of the Preamble.  
executive committee of an organisation known  
as the Citizens' War Chest a sum representing the  
unexpended residue of moneys which were raised by  
5 voluntary contributions for the purpose of being  
expended in connection with any emergency arising out  
of the war in which His Majesty became engaged on the

fourth day of August, one thousand nine hundred and fourteen: And whereas further moneys may be so raised for such purpose: And whereas the said unexpended residue or such further moneys or some part thereof may not be required for the purpose for which the same was raised: And whereas it is desirable that authority be given for the appropriation of the said unexpended residue or further moneys or any part thereof for other purposes: Be it therefore enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

Short title.

**1.** This Act may be cited as the "Citizens' War Chest Enabling Act, 1919." 15

Interpretation.

**2.** In this Act, unless the context otherwise requires—

"The committee" means the executive committee of the Citizens' War Chest as the same is now and shall from time to time be constituted, and includes a majority of those members of the Committee who shall be present at and constitute a meeting thereof. 20

"The fund" means the unexpended residue and the further moneys mentioned in the preamble of this Act which are or shall from time to time be under the control of the committee. 25

Power for the committee to make payments for charitable purposes.

**3.** The committee, with the consent of the Governor, may expend the fund or any part thereof for any charitable purpose which the committee shall think fit. 30

Payments to treasurers to be a discharge.

**4.** The receipt of the treasurer or of a principal officer of a charitable organisation for any moneys so paid shall be a sufficient discharge to the committee, and the committee shall be under no liability to see to the application of any moneys so paid. 35
