
A BILL

To amend the Returned Soldiers and Sailors Employment Act, 1919, by limiting its duration.

[MR. GEORGE CANN;—23 *November*, 1921.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of
5 the same, as follows —

1. This Act may be cited as the “Returned Soldiers and Sailors Employment (Amendment) Act, 1921.” Short title.

2. The Returned Soldiers and Sailors Employment Act, 1919, is amended by adding after section nineteen
10 the following new section:—

20. This Act shall be in force until the thirty-first day of December, one thousand nine hundred and twenty-one, and no longer. Duration of Act.
