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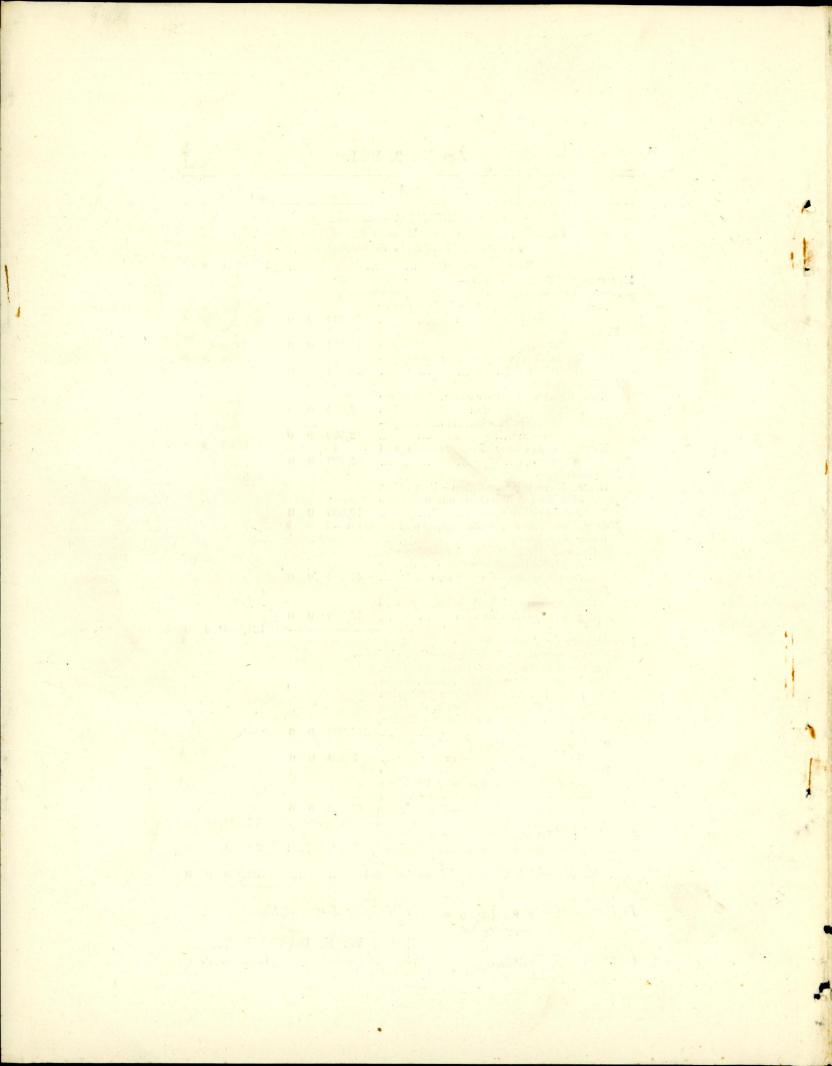

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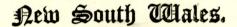

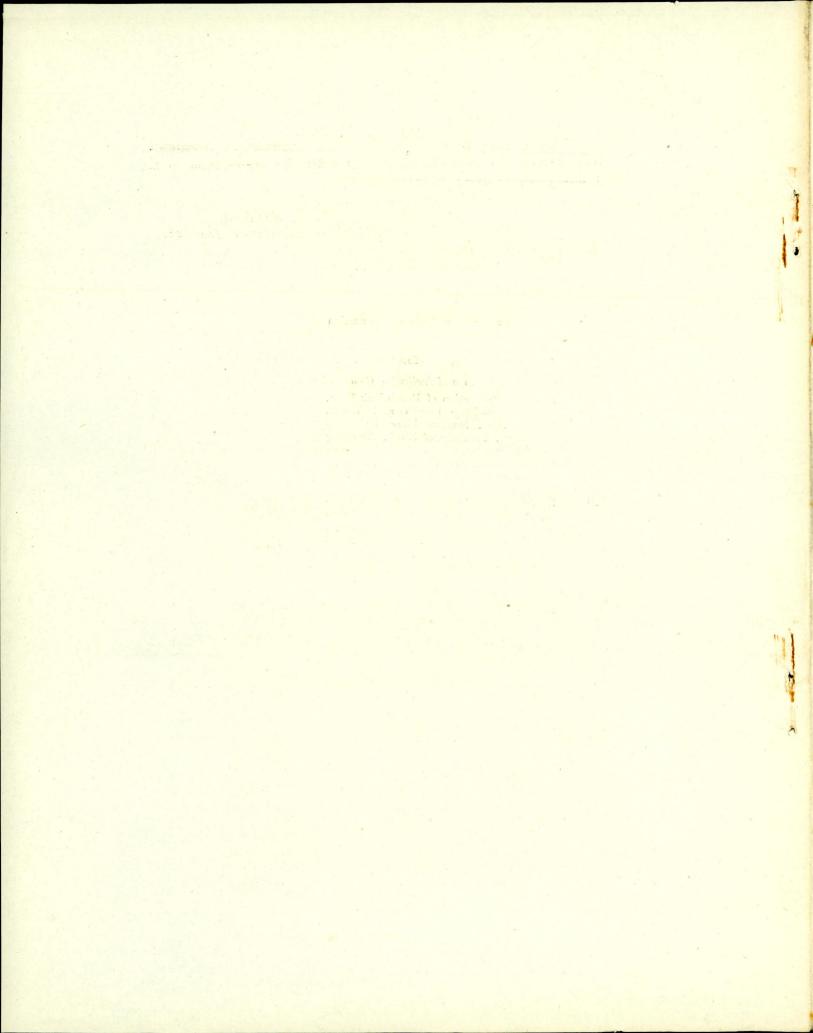

Act No. , 1921.

An Act to apply certain sums out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund towards the Services of the Year 1921-1922, and out of the Public Works Fund, and out of the General Loan Account for Services to be hereafter provided for by Loan.

WHEREAS we Your Majesty's most dutiful and Preamble. loyal subjects, the Members of the Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, have resolved to grant to Your Majesty the sum of 5 Three millions and eight thousand eight hundred pounds, that is to say—

Out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund, the sum of Two millions one hundred and twenty-six thousand eight hundred pounds, being the sum 124— required

required to defray the expenses of the various Departments and Services of the State during othe month of December or following month of the financial year ending thirtieth day of
