WHEREAS we Your Majesty's most dutiful and Preamble. loyal subjects, the Members of the Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, have resolved to grant to Your Majesty the sum of Two millions seven hundred and fifty-six thousand four hundred and fifty pounds, that is to say—


