## Act No. 34, 1920.

An Act to amend the Sydney Harbour Trust Act, 1900; and for purposes connected therewith. [Assented to, 29th December, 1920.]

**B**E it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

**1.** This Act may be cited as the "Sydney Harbour Trust (Amendment) Act, 1920." Short title.

**2.** This Act shall commence on the first day of July, one thousand nine hundred and twenty. Commencement.

**3.** Section seventy-five of the Sydney Harbour Trust Act, 1900, is amended by omitting the words "being not less than three and a half, and not more than four per centum per annum" and by inserting in lieu thereof the words "being interest at a rate not exceeding the average rate of interest paid by the Government on loan moneys." Amendment of Sydney Harbour Trust Act, 1900, s. 75.

ACT NO. 100

1930

AN ACT TO AMEND THE BANKING ACT, 1923, AND TO REPEAL THE BANKING ACT, 1925.

ENACTED BY THE PARLIAMENT OF NEW SOUTH WALES: ASSEMBLY CHAMBER, SYDNEY, THIS TWELFTH DAY OF DECEMBER, 1930.

1. This Act shall be read as if it were an Act of the Parliament of New South Wales.

2. This Act shall commence on the first day of July next after the day on which it is assented to.

3. Section twenty-five of the Sydney Harbour Trust Ordinance, 1900, is amended by substituting the words "being not less than three and a half, and not more than four per centum per annum" and by inserting in the third of the words "being interest at a rate not exceeding the average rate of interest paid by the Government on its loan money".
