Act No. 16, 1920.

An Act to amend the Totalizator Act, 1916, and the Totalizator (Amendment) Act, 1919; and for purposes connected therewith. [Assented to, 2nd December, 1920.]

**B**E it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

**1.** This Act may be cited as the "Totalizator (Amendment) Act, 1920," and shall be read with the Totalizator Act, 1916 (hereinafter called the Principal Act) as amended by the Totalizator (Amendment) Act, 1919.

**2.** The Principal Act is amended as follows :—

(1) Section two: Omit the words “Colonial Secretary” as inserted by subsection one of section two of the Totalizator (Amendment) Act, 1919, and insert in lieu thereof the words “Colonial Treasurer.”

Any such amount may be recovered from such club as a Crown debt in any court of competent jurisdiction.


