Act No. , 1920.

An Act to enable a certain Parliamentary Select Committee to sit during the adjournment or prorogation of Parliament; and for purposes connected therewith.

**B**E it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

**1.** This Act may be cited as the "Parliamentary Select Committee (Agricultural Industry) Enabling Act, 1920." Short title.

**2.** It is hereby declared that the Select Committee of the Legislative Council appointed on the twenty-third day of September, one thousand nine hundred and twenty, to inquire into and report upon the Agricultural Industry, may lawfully sit during the period for which Parliament stands adjourned or prorogued, and do all such things as such Committee lawfully may do while Parliament is in session. Certain Select Committee may sit, &c., during prorogation.
