An Act to sanction the earrying out of certain works to augment the water supply of the Municipality of Armidale; and for purposes connected therewith. [Assented to, 24th November, 1922.]

DE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the "Armidale Water Short title. Supply Act, 1922." 2.

The construction of an earth dam on Dumaresq Creek, 50 feet high, with a concrete core, to impound about 200,000,000 gallons; a pipe line about 1,386 feet long and 10 inches in diameter from the dam to the present gravitation main; and an additional service reservoir with a capacity of about 600,000 gallons, and all works incidental thereto, such works to be completed under the direction of the Secretary for Public Works; the whole to be subject to such modifications as the Constructing Authority may think advisable.
