A BILL

To make certain alterations in the provisions for the pensions of District Court judges; and to amend the District Courts Act, 1912, and certain other Acts.

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows :—

1. This Act may be cited as the "District Courts Short title. (Judges Pensions) Act, 1922."

2. The District Courts Act, 1912, is amended as follows:—

- (a) By omitting from subsection one of section twenty the word "twenty" and inserting in lieu thereof the word "fifteen." 5
- (b) By omitting from subsection two of the same section the word "two" and by inserting in lieu thereof the word "three."
