Act No. 26, 1922.

An Act to amend the Friendly Societies Act, 1912.
[Assented to. 24th November, 1922.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the "Friendly Societies (Amendment) Act, 1922," and shall be construed with the Friendly Societies Act, 1912, as amended by subsequent Acts. Short title.

2. The Friendly Societies Act, 1912, is amended by the addition to section eighty-one of the following words:—"Provided that payment to any one or more societies in respect of any member shall not exceed the sum payable in respect of a funeral donation of fifty pounds." Amendment of 1912 No. 46, s. 81.
