An Act to exempt dentists and certain other persons from serving upon juries; to amend the law as to jurors districts, the service of juror's summons, and the preparation of jury lists; to amend the Jury Act, 1912; and for purposes connected therewith. [Assented to, 25th September, 1924.]

B^E it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows :—

1. This Act may be cited as the "Jury (Amendment) Short title. Act, 1924."


