An Act to sanction the construction of works of water supply for the Municipality of Queanbeyan; to enable the Government of the Commonwealth of Australia to recover amounts due and payable by the council of that municipality for water supplied for distribution by such works; to amend the Public Works Act, 1912, and certain other Acts; and for purposes connected therewith. WHEREAS negotiations are pending between the Preamble. Government of the Commonwealth of Australia, the Government of the State of New South Wales, and the council of the Municipality of Queanbeyan with regard to the construction of works of water supply for the

the said municipality and the supply of water by the Commonwealth for distribution by such works: And whereas it is desirable that, subject to this Act, the works should be constructed by the Secretary for Public Works under the provisions of the Public Works Act, 1912: Be it therefore enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

Short title and commencement. 1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Queanbeyan

Water Supply Act, 1924."

(2) This Act shall come into operation on a date to be appointed by the Governor and notified in the Gazette.

Work sanctioned.

- 2. (1) The carrying out of the works described in the Schedule to this Act is hereby sanctioned, and the Secretary for Public Works is empowered to carry out the said works under the provisions of the Public Works Act, 1912.
- (2) The said works shall be deemed to be authorised works within the meaning of the Public Works Act, 1912.
- (3) The provisions of section thirty-four and thirty-five of the Public Works Act, 1912, shall not apply in respect of the said works.

Cost.

3. The carrying out of the said works described in the Schedule, exclusive of land resumptions, is estimated at twenty-six thousand two hundred pounds, and such estimated cost shall not, under any circumstances, be exceeded by more than ten per centum.

Plan.

4. The plan of the works set out in the Schedule is the plan marked "Queanbeyan Water Supply," signed by the Sceretary for Public Works and countersigned by the Chief Engineer for Water Supply and Sewerage, and deposited in the office of the said Secretary.

Receiver.

5. If the council of the Municipality of Queanbeyan makes default for three months in the due payment of any amounts payable to the Commonwealth of Australia under any agreement for the supply of water by the Commonwealth

Commonwealth, a receiver may be appointed by the Supreme Court in its equitable jurisdiction on the application of the Commonwealth, and such receiver shall have all the powers and duties of a receiver appointed under any provision of the Local Government Act, 1919.




