Act No. 34, 1924.

An Act to promote the revision of the Statute Law by repealing enactments which have ceased to be in force or have become unnecessary. [Assented to, 9th December, 1924.]

WHEREAS it is expedient that certain enactments Preamble.
which may be regarded as spent or have ceased
to be in force otherwise than by express specific repeal
by the Legislature, or have by lapse of time or otherwise
become unnecessary, should be expressly and specifically
repealed: Be it therefore enacted by the King's Most

Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

Short title.

1. This Act may be cited as the "Statute Law Revision Act, 1924."

Repeals. Schedule. 2. The enactments mentioned in the Schedule to this Act are to the extent therein expressed, and subject to the provisions of this Act, hereby repealed.

Savings.

- 3. (1) Where any enactment not comprised in the Schedule to this Act has been repealed confirmed revived or perpetuated by any enactment hereby repealed, the repeal confirmation revivor or perpetuation shall not be affected by the repeal effected by this Act.
- (2) The repeal by this Act of any enactment or schedule shall not affect any enactment in which the enactment or schedule has been applied incorporated or referred to.
 - (3) This Act shall not affect—
 - (a) the validity invalidity effect or consequences of anything already done or suffered; or
 - (b) any existing status or capacity; or
 - (c) any right title obligation or liability already acquired accrued or incurred, or any remedy or proceeding in respect thereof; or
 - (d) any release or discharge of or from any debt penalty obligation liability claim or demand; or
 - (e) any indemnity; or
 - (f) the proof of any past act or thing, or the admissibility or inadmissibility of evidence with respect thereto.
 - (4) This Act shall not affect—
 - (a) any principle or rule of law or equity; or
 - (b) any established jurisdiction, form or course of pleading, practice or procedure; or

(c)

- (c) the general or public nature of any statute; or
- (d) any existing usage franchise liberty custom privilege restriction exemption office appointment payment allowance emolument or benefit; or
- (e) any prospective right—
 notwithstanding that the same respectively may have
 been in any manner affirmed recognised or derived by
 in or from any enactment hereby repealed.
- (5) This Act shall not revive or restore any jurisdiction office duty drawback fee payment franchise liberty custom liability right title privilege restriction exemption usage practice procedure form of punishment or other matter or thing not now existing or in force.

Act No. 34, 1924.

An Act to promote the revision of the Statute Law by repealing enactments which have ceased to be in force or have become unnecessary. [Assented to, 9th December, 1924.]

WHEREAS it is expedient that certain enactments Preamble.
which may be regarded as spent or have ceased
to be in force otherwise than by express specific repeal
by the Legislature, or have by lapse of time or otherwise
become unnecessary, should be expressly and specifically
repealed: Be it therefore enacted by the King's Most

Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

Short title.

1. This Act may be cited as the "Statute Law Revision Act, 1924."

Repeals. Schedule.

2. The enactments mentioned in the Schedule to this Act are to the extent therein expressed, and subject to the provisions of this Act, hereby repealed.

Savings.

- 3. (1) Where any enactment not comprised in the Schedule to this Act has been repealed confirmed revived or perpetuated by any enactment hereby repealed, the repeal confirmation revivor or perpetuation shall not be affected by the repeal effected by this Act.
- (2) The repeal by this Act of any enactment or schedule shall not affect any enactment in which the enactment or schedule has been applied incorporated or referred to.
 - (3) This Act shall not affect—
 - (a) the validity invalidity effect or consequences of anything already done or suffered; or
 - (b) any existing status or capacity; or
 - (c) any right title obligation or liability already acquired accrued or incurred, or any remedy or proceeding in respect thereof; or
 - (d) any release or discharge of or from any debt penalty obligation liability claim or demand; or
 - (e) any indemnity; or
 - (f) the proof of any past act or thing, or the admissibility or inadmissibility of evidence with respect thereto.
 - (4) This Act shall not affect—
 - (a) any principle or rule of law or equity; or
 - (b) any established jurisdiction, form or course of pleading, practice or procedure; or

- (c) the general or public nature of any statute; or
- (d) any existing usage franchise liberty custom privilege restriction exemption office appointment payment allowance emolument or benefit; or
- (e) any prospective right—
 notwithstanding that the same respectively may have
 been in any manner affirmed recognised or derived by
 in or from any enactment hereby repealed.
- (5) This Act shall not revive or restore any jurisdiction office duty drawback fee payment franchise liberty custom liability right title privilege restriction exemption usage practice procedure form of punishment or other matter or thing not now existing or in force.


MEMORANDUM.

The object of this Bill is to relieve the Statute Book of a large number of Acts which are spent or have ceased to be in force otherwise than by express specific repeal by the Legislature, or have, by lapse of time or otherwise, become unnecessary.

The Acts to be repealed by the Bill include temporary Acts that have expired, Acts the operation of which has been exhausted, Acts the operation of which has been virtually exhausted (i.e., in the case of authorised public works as to which no further action is intended to be taken towards their completion in the form originally authorised), Acts of which formal parts remain although the operative sections have been repealed by various consolidations, and Acts which have become obsolete or have been superseded by later legislation, including the legislation of the Federal Parliament. In addition, the Bill expressly repeals certain Acts which were disallowed by the Crown before the days of responsible government, as well as certain Bills which were from time to time reserved for, but did not receive, the assent of the Crown, the last of these being a Bill reserved in 1896.

The Bill is on the same lines as the Statute Law Revision Act, 1898, and contains a similar saving clause, the general effect of which is to preserve untouched all the past operation of the Acts repealed, even where that past operation is of a permanent and continuing character.

WHEREAS it is expedient that certain enactments Preamble.
