Act No. 13, 1922.

An Act to apply certain sums out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund towards the Services of the Year 1922-1923, and out of the Public Works Fund, and out of the General Loan Account for Services to be hereafter provided for by Loan. [Assented to, 5th October, 1922.]

WHEREAS we Your Majesty's most dutiful and Preamble. loyal subjects, the Members of the Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, have resolved to grant to Your Majesty the sum of Two millions six hundred and forty-six thousand one hundred pounds, that is to say—

Out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund the sum of Two millions two hundred and eighteen thousand eight hundred pounds, being the sum required
