## Act No. 11, 1924.

An Act to apply certain sums out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund towards the Services of the Year 1924-1925, and out of the Public Works Fund, and out of the General Loan Account for Services to be hereafter provided for by Loan. [Assented to, 3rd October, 1924.]

**W**HEREAS we Your Majesty's most dutiful and Preamble.  
loyal subjects, the Members of the Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, have resolved to grant to Your Majesty the sum of Three millions one hundred and seventy-five thousand and fifty pounds, that is to say—

Out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund the sum of Two millions two hundred and seventy-seven thousand pounds, being the sum required

And whereas we desire to make good out of the said Funds and the General Loan Account the sum so granted to His Majesty : Be it therefore enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows :—

**1.** Out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund of New South Wales there shall and may be issued and applied for or towards making good the Supply so resolved to be granted to His Majesty, the sum of Two millions two hundred and seventy-seven thousand pounds, to be expended at the rates which are shown on the Estimates for the financial year ending thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and twenty-five, as laid upon the Table of the House, to defray the expenses of the various Departments and Services of the State during the month of October, or following month of the financial year ending thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and twenty-five, subject to the rate of any reduction that may hereafter be made in the expenditure of the year 1924-1925.

**2.** Out of the Public Works Fund there shall and may be issued and applied for or towards making good the Supply so resolved to be granted to His Majesty, the sum of Seventeen thousand three hundred pounds for the Services specified in Schedule A hereto annexed.
