Act No. , 1924.

An Act to make liable to assessment and rating under the provisions of the Sydney Corporation Act, 1902, schools under the Public Instruction Act of 1880 and certified schools under the Public Instruction (Amendment) Act, 1916, and playgrounds used in connection with any such schools; to amend the Sydney Corporation Act, 1902, the Sydney Corporation (Amendment) Act, 1924; and for purposes connected therewith.

Sydney Corporation (Further Amendment).

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of
 5 the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the "Sydney Corporation Short title.
 (Further Amendment) Act, 1924."
2. Subsection five of section one hundred and ten of Amendment.
 the Sydney Corporation Act, 1902, as amended by Act No. 35,
 10 section seven of the Sydney Corporation (Amendment) 1902,
 Act, 1924, is amended by omitting the words "or any s. 110 (5);
 school under the Public Instruction Act of 1880, or Act No. 7,
 certified schools under the Public Instruction Act 1924, s. 7 (c).
 (Amendment) Act, 1916, or any playground used in
 15 connection with any such school."
