Act No. , 1924.

An Act to amend the Gaming and Betting Act, 1912, for the purpose of enabling the Menangle Park Racing Company, Limited, to carry out the purposes of the said Company.

WHEREAS on the passing of the Gaming and Betting Act, 1912, the Menangle Park Race-course was situated beyond the forty miles limit from the General Post Office, Sydney, fixed by that Act: ^{Preamble.}
5 And whereas owing to recent deviations of the Main Southern Railway line, that course is now situated within

within the said forty miles limit: Be it therefore enacted
by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with
the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and
Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament
5 assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. Notwithstanding anything to the contrary in the
Gaming and Betting Act, 1912, the Menangle Park
Racecourse shall be deemed to be situated beyond forty
miles from the General Post Office, Sydney, for all the
10 purposes of that Act.

2. This Act may be cited as the "Gaming and ^{Short title.}
Betting Act Amendment (Menangle Park Racecourse)
Act, 1924."

3. The Company's operations shall be restricted to
15 sixteen days per annum for horse races.

1. Notwithstanding anything to the contrary in the Gaming and Betting Act, 1912, the Menangle Park Racecourse shall be deemed to be situated beyond forty miles from the General Post Office, Sydney, for all the purposes of that Act. 10
