Act No. 9, 1925.

An Act to amend the Auctioneers Licensing Act, 1898, as amended by subsequent Acts. [Assented to, 18th November, 1925.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the "Auctioneers Licensing (Amendment) Act, 1925," and shall be read with the Auctioneers Licensing Act, 1898, as amended by subsequent Acts, which said Act as so amended is hereinafter referred to as the Principal Act. Short title.

2. Subsection one of section six of the Principal Act is amended by omitting the words "an auctioneer's license" and by inserting in lieu thereof the words "a general auctioneer's license." Amendment. Act No. 24, 1898, s. 6.

I have examined this Bill, and find it to correspond in all respects with the Bill as finally passed by both Houses.
