BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the "Auctioneers Short title. Licensing (Amendment) Act, 1925," and shall be read with the Auctioneers Licensing Act, 1898, as amended by subsequent Acts, which said Act as so amended is hereinafter referred to as the Principal Act.


