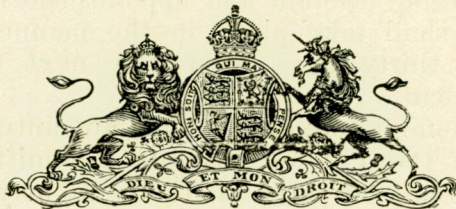

Act No. 12, 1925.

An Act to make further provision for the nomination, election and appointment of the Public Accounts Committee; to enable that Committee to be nominated, elected and appointed for the twenty-seventh Parliament; to amend the Audit Act, 1902; and for purposes connected therewith. [Assented to, 2nd December, 1925.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the "Audit Amendment Short title. (Public Accounts Committee) Act, 1925." 2.

Amendment of Act, 1902, No. 26, s. 16.

2. The Audit Act, 1902, is amended by omitting subsection nine of section sixteen and by inserting in lieu thereof the following new subsection:—

Election where first session has expired before the election of a committee.

(9) Where the first session of any Parliament has expired within thirty days of its commencement without a committee having been appointed the nomination, election and appointment of the committee shall take place in the manner aforesaid within thirty days after the next meeting of Parliament.

Appointment of Public Accounts Committee for the present (27th) Parliament.

3. The nomination, election and appointment of the members of the Public Accounts Committee for the present (twenty-seventh) Parliament may, notwithstanding anything in the Audit Act, 1902, as amended by this Act, be made and held under and in the manner prescribed by the said Act within thirty days from the commencement of this Act.

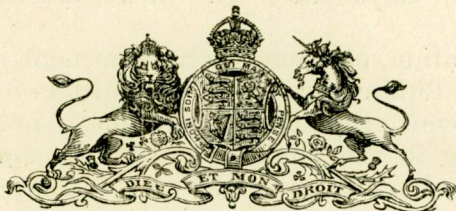

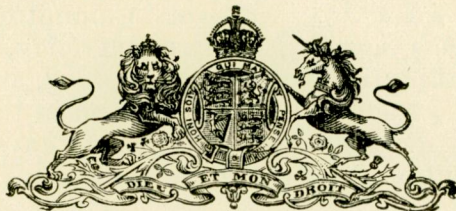
