Act No. , 1925.

An Act to repeal the Juvenile Migrants Apprenticeship Act, 1923; and for purposes connected therewith.

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority 5 of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the "Juvenile Migrants short title. Apprenticeship (Repeal) Act, 1925." 82033

Juvenile Migrants Apprenticeship (Repeal).

2. (1) The Juvenile Migrants Apprenticeship Act, Repeal of Act, 1923 No. 52.

(2) The repeal effected by the last preceding sub-Savings. section shall not affect the future operation of that Act
5 in respect of any juvenile who, prior to the commencement of this Act, signed the statement referred to in section three of that Act.

(3) Nothing in this section shall limit or abridge any saving contained in the Interpretation Act, 1897.
