Act No. 21, 1926.

An Act to extend the powers of the Newcastle District Abattoir Board with regard to the delivery of meat by the Board, with regard to borrowing for the purposes of the Board, and with regard to the inspection of meat slaughtered outside the district of the Board and the products of such meat brought into the district of the Board for human consumption within such district; to make further provision as to the fees of the Board; to amend the Newcastle District Abattoir and Sale-yards Act, 1912, and certain other Acts; to repeal the Newcastle District Abattoir and Sale-yards Amendment Act, 1915; and for purposes connected therewith. Newcastle District Abattoir and Sale-yards (Amendment).

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows :—

- 1.** This Act may be cited as the "Newcastle District Abattoir and Sale-yards (Amendment) Act, 1926," and shall be construed with the Newcastle District Abattoir and Sale-yards Act, 1912, as amended by subsequent Acts, which Act as so amended is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.
- 2.** The Principal Act is amended as follows :—
- (a) by omitting from subsection one of section six the word "fifty-two" and by inserting in lieu thereof the words "one hundred and fifty";
- (b) (i) by omitting from subsection two of the same section the words "one pound" and by inserting in lieu thereof the words "two pounds";
- (ii) by omitting the words "thirty pounds" and by inserting in lieu thereof the words "one hundred pounds."
- 3.** (1) The Principal Act is further amended—
- (a) by inserting the following new section next after section 12A :—
- 12B. The board may undertake the delivery of meat to shops in any prescribed areas of the district and make such charges therefor as it shall think fit.
- (b) by omitting from section thirteen the words "one hundred and fifty-five" and by inserting in lieu thereof the words "one hundred and eighty";
- (c) by inserting in section nineteen after the words "the board" the words "or the Minister for Public Health";
- (d) by inserting at the end of section nineteen the following new subsection :—
- (5) In this section "carcase" shall be deemed to include sausages, saveloys, and other smallgoods manufactured or prepared from a carcase or any portion thereof.
