## Act No. 22, 1926.

An Act to apply certain sums out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund towards the Services of the Year 1926-1927, and out of the Public Works Fund, and out of the General Loan Account for Services to be hereafter provided for by Loan. [Assented to, 1st December, 1926.]

**W**HEREAS we Your Majesty's most dutiful and Preamble. loyal subjects, the Members of the Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, have resolved to grant to Your Majesty the sum of Fourteen millions two hundred and seven thousand two hundred and thirty-five pounds, that is to say—

Out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund the sum of Ten millions five hundred and twenty-six thousand pounds, being the sum required to defray
