Act No. 5, 1925.

An Act to apply certain sums out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund towards the Services of the Year 1925–1926, and out of the Public Works Fund, and out of the General Loan Account for Services to be hereafter provided for by Loan. [Assented to, 1st October, 1925.]

WHEREAS we Your Majesty's most dutiful and Preamble. loyal subjects, the Members of the Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, have resolved to grant to Your Majesty the sum of Three millions one hundred and seventy-nine thousand nine hundred and fifty pounds, that is to say—

Out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund, the sum of Two millions two hundred and seventy-seven thousand pounds, being the sum required to defray

The Treasurer shall issue and pay the said sums Treasurer to for the Services aforesaid in such manner and in such pay under Governor's proportions as the Governor, by Warrants or Orders in Warrant or writing under his hand, and directed to the said Order.
