Act No. 50, 1927.

An Act to validate the title of a certain Homestead Farm. [Assented to, 12th December, 1927.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Crown Lands Short title. (Homestead Farm) Validation Act, 1927."

(2) This Act shall be deemed to have commenced on the fourteenth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and twenty-seven.

2. The title of the Homestead Farm 1918-1, Land Validation. District of Newcastle, shall be deemed to be as valid as if the land therein comprised had on the twentieth day of November, one thousand nine hundred and eighteen, been Crown land available for application for a Homestead Farm.

I have examined this Bill, and find it to correspond in all respects with the Bill as finally passed by both Houses.

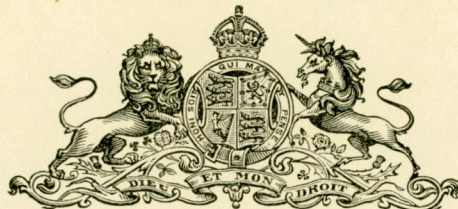
