## Act No. 53, 1927.

An Act to make further provision as to the regulation of electrical installation work; to amend the Electrical Contractors and Electricians Licensing Act, 1924, and certain other Acts; and for purposes connected therewith. [Assented to, 12th December, 1927.]

**B**E it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

**1.** (1) This Act may be cited as the “Electrical Contractors and Electricians Licensing (Amendment) Act, 1927,” and shall be read with the Electrical Contractors and Electricians Licensing Act, 1924, as amended by subsequent Acts. (2)

(2) The Electrical Contractors and Electricians Licensing Act, 1924, as so amended is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.

2. (1) The appointment by the Governor under subsection one of section fifteen of the Principal Act of the first day of February, one thousand nine hundred and twenty-eight, as the appointed day from and after which the provisions of paragraphs (a), (b), and (c) of subsection one of the said section shall have effect, is hereby revoked, and the notification of such appointment published in the Gazette, number one hundred and thirty-one, of the sixteenth day of September, one thousand nine hundred and twenty-seven, is hereby rescinded.

(2) The Governor may at any time after the commencement of this Act appoint a day from and after which the provisions of paragraphs (a), (b), and (c) of subsection one and subsection two of section fifteen of the Principal Act shall have effect.

The day to be so appointed shall be a day not later than the thirty-first day of July, one thousand nine hundred and twenty-eight, and shall be notified in the Gazette.
