Act No. 21, 1928.

An Act to amend the Electrical Contractors and Electricians Licensing Act, 1924, and certain other Acts in certain respects; and for purposes connected therewith. [Assented to, 16th June, 1928.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the "Electrical Contractors and Electricians Licensing (Amendment) Act, 1928." Short title.

2. The Electrical Contractors and Electricians Licensing (Amendment) Act, 1927, is amended by omitting from subsection two of section two the words "shall be a day not later than the thirty-first day of July, one thousand nine hundred and twenty-eight, and." Amendment of Act No. 53, 1927, s. 2 (2).

The Executive Committee, in pursuance of the powers conferred upon it by the Articles of Association, has resolved to propose the following amendments to the Articles of Association, 1928.

1. To amend Article 1, so that the Executive Committee shall consist of seven members, five of whom shall be elected by the members of the Executive Committee, and two of whom shall be appointed by the Council.
2. To amend Article 2, so that the Executive Committee shall have the right to elect a Chairman and a Vice-Chairman, and to elect a Secretary and a Treasurer.
3. To amend Article 3, so that the Executive Committee shall have the right to elect a Chairman and a Vice-Chairman, and to elect a Secretary and a Treasurer.
4. To amend Article 4, so that the Executive Committee shall have the right to elect a Chairman and a Vice-Chairman, and to elect a Secretary and a Treasurer.
5. To amend Article 5, so that the Executive Committee shall have the right to elect a Chairman and a Vice-Chairman, and to elect a Secretary and a Treasurer.
