BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows :--

Lismore Markets and Cattle Sale-yards (Vesting).

Vesting as Crown lands. 2. (1) The land described in the Schedule to this Act is hereby vested in His Majesty and shall from the commencement of this Act be deemed to be Crown lands within the meaning of the Crown Lands Consolidation Act, 1913, as amended by subsequent Acts, free from any dedication or trust.

(2) The said lands shall be deemed to be land temporarily reserved from sale or lease under the said Crown Lands Consolidation Act, 1913, and may on revocation of the reserve in accordance with the provisions of that Act be disposed of or otherwise dealt with under the provisions of that Act or the Public Roads Act, 1902.

SCHEDULE.

Lismore Markets and Cattle Sale-yards (Vesting) Bill, 1928.

EXPLANATORY NOTE.

THE object of this Bill is to vest in His Majesty certain land originally dedicated and granted to the Municipal District of Lismore upon trust to use as a Reserve for Market, and later used as a Site for a Cattle Sale-yards and Market by the authority of the Lismore Markets and Cattle Sale-yards Act, 1904.

The Site is no longer required for those purposes, and it is intended to add the greater part of the area to the present park (Spinks Park), and to utilise portion of the area for Soldiers' Memorial Swimming Baths.
