A BILL

To amend the Saturday Half Holiday Act,
1910, in certain respects.

[MR. STUART-ROBERTSON;—27 *March*, 1929.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty,
by and with the advice and consent of the Legis-
lative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South
Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of
5 the same, as follows:—

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Saturday Half Short title.
Holiday (Amendment) Act, 1929."

(2) The Saturday Half Holiday Act, 1910. as
10 amended by subsequent Acts, is in this Act referred to
as the Principal Act.

2. The Principal Act is amended by inserting after Amendment
of Principal
Act
the word "district," first occurring in clause (3), the
words "shall in every week be half-past twelve o'clock
15 in the afternoon of Saturday, and six o'clock in the
afternoon of Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday,
and Friday."

7. BEEF

To amend the Saturday Half Holiday Act, 1910, in certain respects.

[MR. STUART BOGERTON:—37. Wages, 1937.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty in Council with the advice and consent of the Lords Spiritual and Temporal, Great Officers of State, Privy Counsellors, and of the Commons in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, that the Act in that behalf made, intituled "An Act to amend the Saturday Half Holiday Act, 1910," may be cited as the "Saturday Half Holiday (Amendment) Act, 1937."

1. (1) The Act may be cited as the "Saturday Half Holiday (Amendment) Act, 1937."

(2) The Saturday Half Holiday Act, 1910, as amended by subsequent Acts, in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.

2. The Principal Act is amended by inserting after section 2 the words "district" and occurring in clause (2) of the said section, shall in every case be half-holiday except in the absence of Saturday, and six o'clock in the afternoon of Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday, and Friday."
