Act No. , 1929.

An Act to apply certain sums out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund, the Government Railways and Tramways Fund, and the Sydney Harbour Trust Fund, towards the Services of the Year 1929–1930, and out of the General Loan Account for Services to be hereafter provided for by Loan.

WHEREAS we Your Majesty's most dutiful and Preamble. loyal subjects, the Members of the Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, have resolved to grant to Your Majesty the sum of 5 Three millions eight hundred and seventy-one thousand nine hundred and twenty pounds, that is to say—

Out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund, the sum of One million three hundred and eighty thousand eight hundred pounds, being the sum required 91— to

to defray the expenses of the various Departments and Services of the State during the month of December or following month of the financial year ending thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and thirty.
