BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the "Constitution Short title. (Amendment) Act, 1930."

2. The Constitution (Legislative Council) Amendment Act, 1929, and section 7A of the Constitution Act, 1902, as amended by subsequent Acts, and the Constitution Further Amendment (Referendum) Act, 1930, are repealed. Repeal of Act No. 28, 1929, Act No. 32, 1902, s. 7A, and Act No. 2, 1930.
