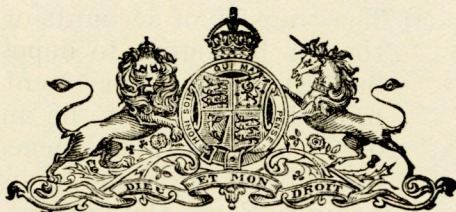

An Act to amend in certain respects the Government Savings Bank Act, 1906, as amended by subsequent Acts; and for purposes connected therewith. [Assented to, 18th September, 1931.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Government Savings Bank Acts Amendment Act, 1931."

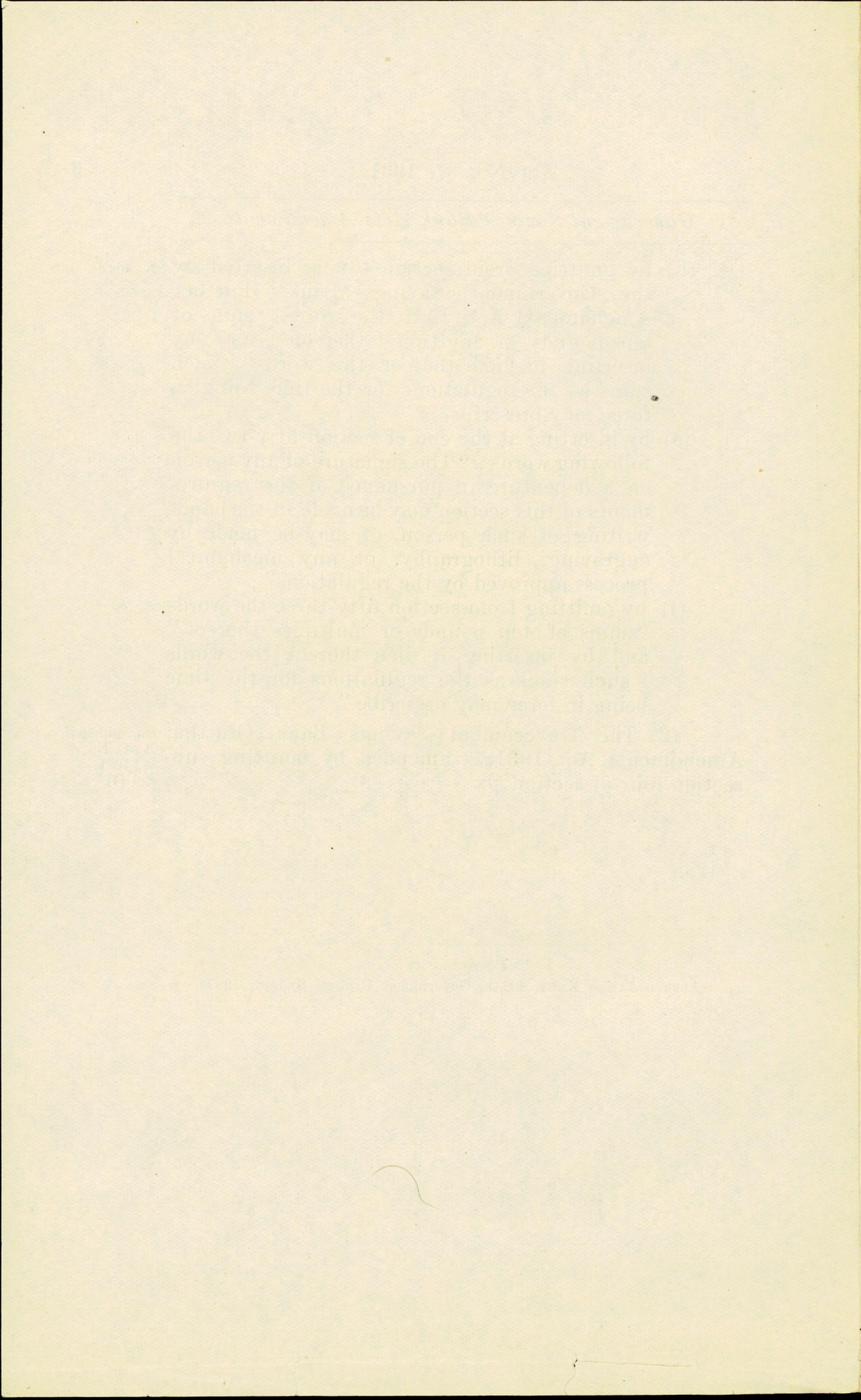

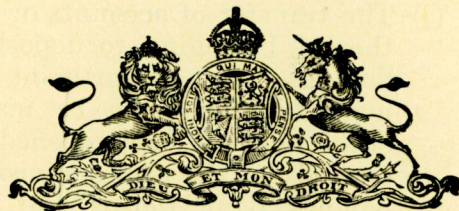
