An Act to amend the Marketing of Primary Products Act, 1927-1930, in certain respects; and for purposes connected therewith. [Assented to, 17th March, 1931.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Marketing of Primary Products (Amendment) Act, 1931," and shall be read and construed with the Marketing of Primary Products Act, 1927-1930, in this Act referred to as the Principal Act. Short title

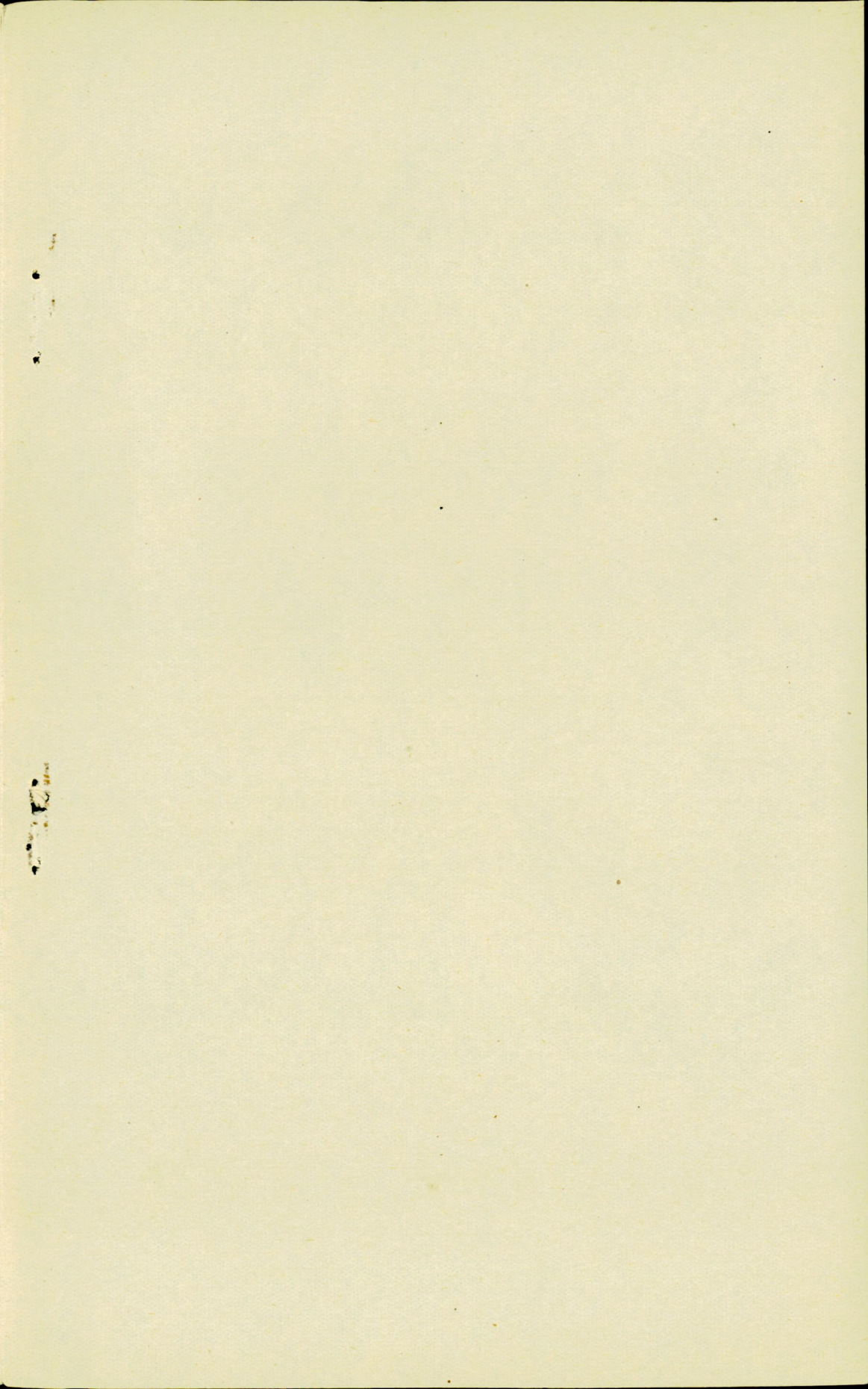

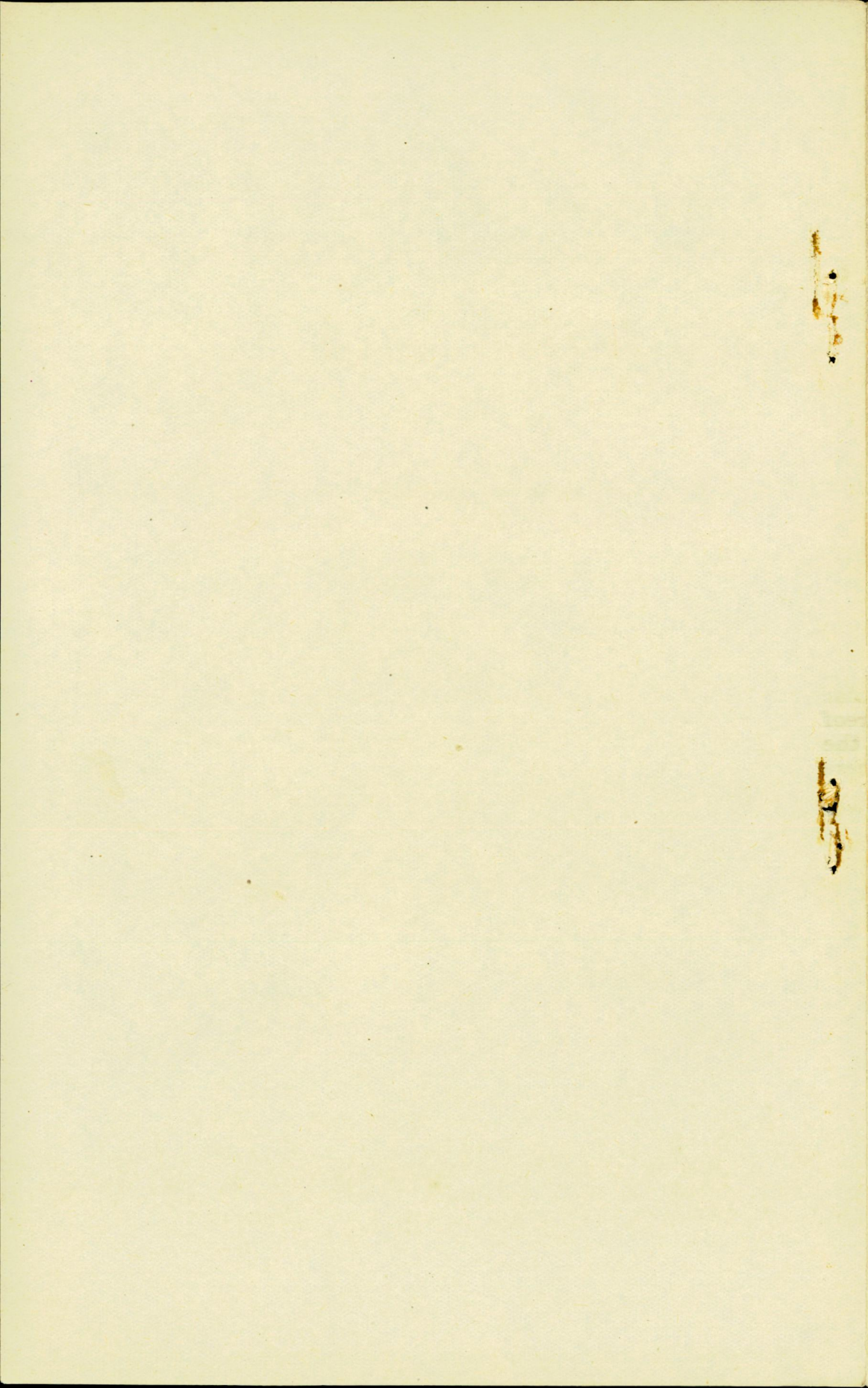

Hydrolysis of Various Esters (continued)

The hydrolysis of an ester is a reversible reaction. The rate of hydrolysis is affected by the concentration of the reactants and the presence of a catalyst. In this experiment, the hydrolysis of various esters was studied under different conditions.

- (i) The hydrolysis of methyl acetate was studied at different temperatures. The rate of hydrolysis was found to increase with increasing temperature.
- (ii) The hydrolysis of ethyl acetate was studied in the presence and absence of a catalyst. The rate of hydrolysis was found to be much faster in the presence of a catalyst.
- (iii) The hydrolysis of propyl acetate was studied at different concentrations. The rate of hydrolysis was found to increase with increasing concentration.
- (iv) The hydrolysis of butyl acetate was studied at different pH values. The rate of hydrolysis was found to be highest at a pH of 7.
- (v) The hydrolysis of pentyl acetate was studied at different ionic strengths. The rate of hydrolysis was found to be affected by the ionic strength.
- (vi) The hydrolysis of hexyl acetate was studied at different dielectric constants. The rate of hydrolysis was found to be affected by the dielectric constant.
- (vii) The hydrolysis of heptyl acetate was studied at different viscosities. The rate of hydrolysis was found to be affected by the viscosity.
- (viii) The hydrolysis of octyl acetate was studied at different surface areas. The rate of hydrolysis was found to be affected by the surface area.
- (ix) The hydrolysis of nonyl acetate was studied at different particle sizes. The rate of hydrolysis was found to be affected by the particle size.
- (x) The hydrolysis of decyl acetate was studied at different molecular weights. The rate of hydrolysis was found to be affected by the molecular weight.
