## Act No. 4, 1931.

An Act to amend the law as to the levying of stormwater drainage rates by the Metropolitan Water, Sewerage, and Drainage Board; to amend the Metropolitan Water, Sewerage, and Drainage Act, 1924-1930, in certain respects; and for purposes connected therewith. [Assented to, 16th February, 1931.]

**B**E it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

**1.** (1) This Act may be cited as the "Metropolitan Short title. Water, Sewerage, and Drainage (Amendment) Act, 1931."

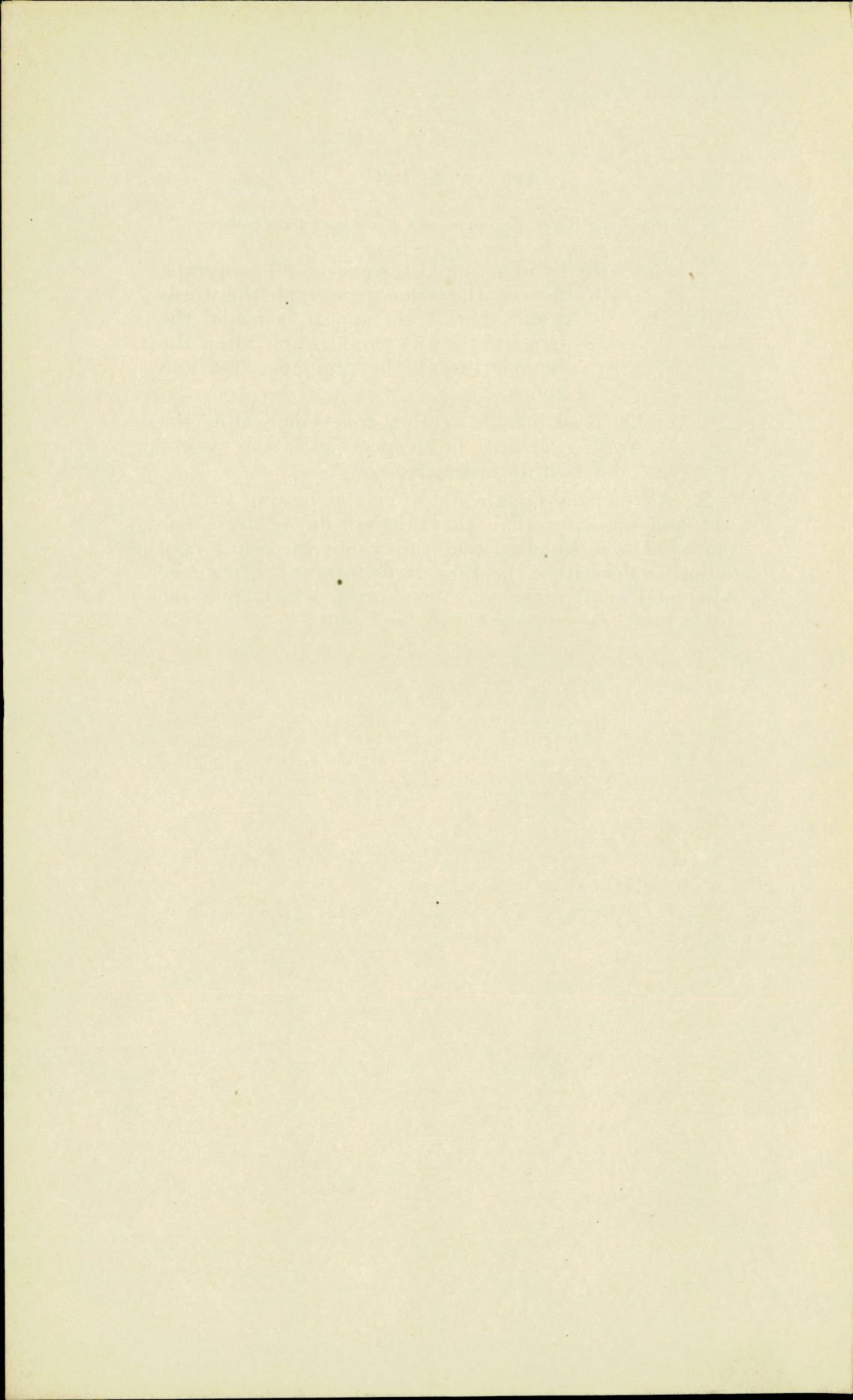
