Act No. , 1932.

An Act to relieve the Consolidated Revenue Fund from certain payments; to amend the Public Health Act, 1902; and the Sydney Corporation Act, 1902; and for purposes connected therewith.

**B**E it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows.—

**1.** This Act may be cited as the "Public Health (Inspectors' Salaries) Amendment Act, 1932." Short title.

**2.** The Public Health Act, 1902, is amended by omitting subsection three of section ninety-four. Amendment of Act No. 30, 1902, s. 94.

*Public Health (Inspectors' Salaries) Amendment.*

3. The Sydney Corporation Act, 1902, is amended by omitting from subsection two of section fifty-eight the words "one half of such salary shall be payable out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund, and one half" and 5 by inserting in lieu thereof the words "such salary shall be payable."

4. The Consolidated Revenue Fund is hereby relieved of any liability in respect of any obligation under subsection three of section ninety-four of the 10 Public Health Act, 1902, which had accrued prior to the commencement of this Act and the payment of which out of some vote had not prior to such commencement been approved by the Minister for Public Health.
