An Act to relieve the Consolidated Revenue Fund from certain payments; to amend the Public Health Act, 1902; and the Sydney Corporation Act, 1902; and for purposes connected therewith. [Assented to, 30th June, 1932.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows.—

1. This Act may be cited as the "Public Health (Inspectors' Salaries) Amendment Act, 1932." Short title.
