A BILL

To amend the Saturday Half Holiday Act,
1910, in certain respects.

[MR. STUART-ROBERTSON ;—24 *March*, 1931.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty,
by and with the advice and consent of the Legis-
lative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South
Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of
5 the same, as follows :—

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Saturday Half Short title.
Holiday (Amendment) Act, 1931."

(2) The Saturday Half Holiday Act, 1910, as
amended by subsequent Acts, is in this Act referred to
10 as the Principal Act.

2. The Principal Act is amended by inserting after Amendment
of Principal
Act
the word "district," first occurring in clause three, the
words "shall in every week be twelve o'clock noon on
Saturday, and five thirty o'clock in the afternoon of
15 Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday, and Friday."
