WHEREAS we Your Majesty's most dutiful and Preamble loyal subjects, the Members of the Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, have resolved to grant to Your Majesty the sum of Two millions six hundred and forty-eight thousand eight hundred pounds, that is to say—

Out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund, the sum of One million three hundred and sixty-three thousand pounds, being the sum required to defray the expenses of the various Departments and Services of the State during the month of May
