Act No. 15, 1931.

An Act to apply certain sums out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund, the Government Railways and Tramways Fund, and the Sydney Harbour Trust Fund, towards the Services of the Year 1930-1931. [Assented to, 5th May, 1931.]

**W**HEREAS we Your Majesty's most dutiful and <sup>Preamble</sup> loyal subjects, the Members of the Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, have resolved to grant to Your Majesty the sum of Two millions six hundred and forty-eight thousand eight hundred pounds, that is to say—

Out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund, the sum of One million three hundred and sixty-three thousand pounds, being the sum required to defray the expenses of the various Departments and Services of the State during the month of  
May

**4.** The Treasurer shall issue and pay the said sums for the Services aforesaid in such manner and in such proportions as the Governor, by Warrants or Orders in writing under his hand, and directed to the said Treasurer, shall from time to time order and direct. And the payments so to be made shall be charged upon and paid out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund, the Government Railways and Tramways Fund, and the Sydney Harbour Trust Fund, respectively.

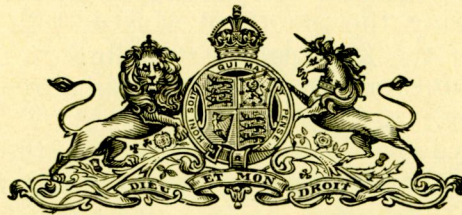
