## Act No. 24, 1933.

An Act to amend the Farmers' Relief Act, 1932;  
and for purposes connected therewith.  
[Assented to, 20th December, 1933.]

**B**E it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

**1.** (1) This Act may be cited as the "Farmers' Relief (Amendment) Act, 1933." Short title.

(2) The Farmers' Relief Act, 1932, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the Farmers' Relief Act, 1932-1933.

**2.** The Farmers' Relief Act, 1932, is amended by omitting from subsection one of section eight the word "twelve" and by inserting in lieu thereof the word "fifteen."

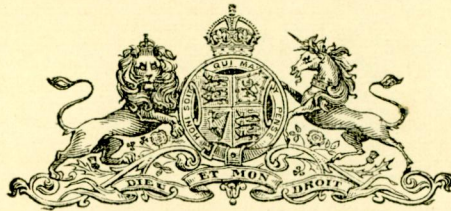
