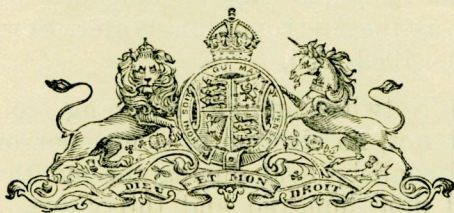

Act No. 16, 1935.

An Act to alter the law relating to elections of members of the Metropolitan Water, Sewerage and Drainage Board, and to make further provisions in relation thereto; to amend the Metropolitan Water, Sewerage and Drainage Act, 1924-1935, in certain respects; and for purposes connected therewith. [Assented to, 21st March, 1935.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Metropolitan Water, Sewerage, and Drainage Amendment (Elections) Act, 1935." Short title.

(2) This Act shall be read and construed with the Metropolitan Water, Sewerage and Drainage Act, 1932-1935, in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.

(3) The Principal Act as amended by this Act may be cited as the Metropolitan Water, Sewerage, and Drainage Acts, 1932-1935.

2. (1) (a) Notwithstanding anything contained in the Principal Act, no election of a member or members of the Board shall be held during the month of March, one thousand nine hundred and thirty-five.

(b) All Acts and proceedings done and taken for the purposes of or in relation to elections of members of the Board proposed to be held during the said month are hereby annulled.

(c) Every person to whom a ballot-paper for such proposed elections has been issued shall forthwith return the same to the Returning Officer in the envelope provided for that purpose.

(d) The Returning Officer shall forthwith destroy all ballot-papers so returned to him.

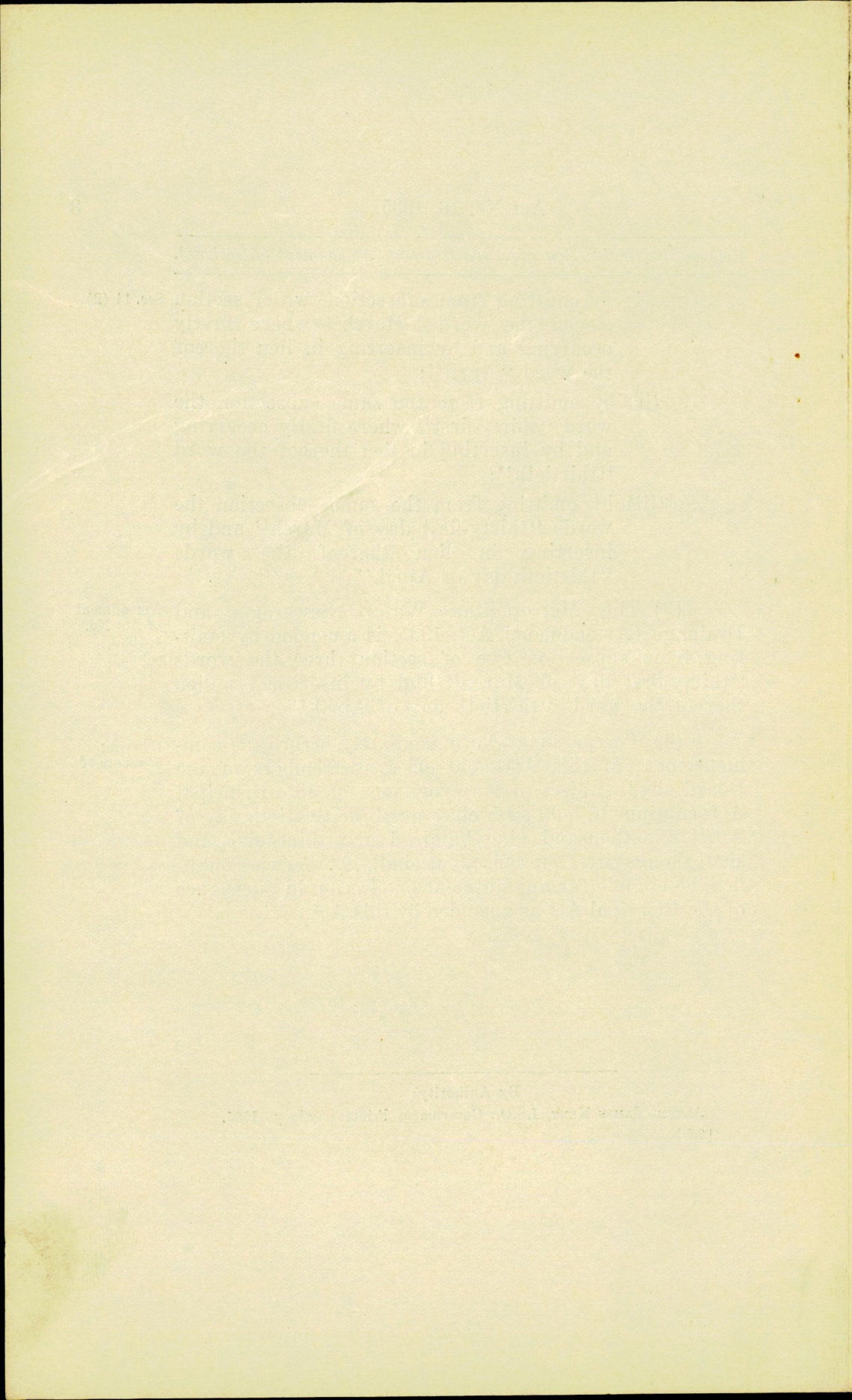

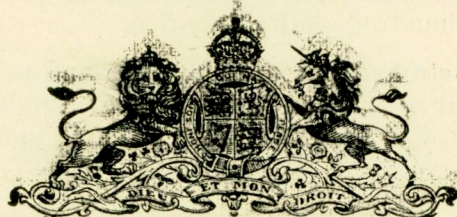
