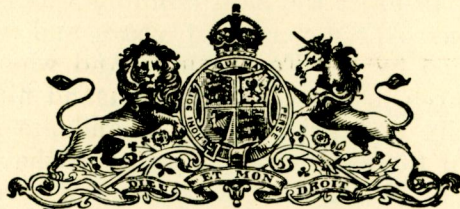

WHEREAS the New South Wales Public School Teachers' Federation (hereinafter referred to as "the Federation") is registered as a Trade Union under the Trade Union Act, 1881: And whereas the Federation is the owner of a piece of land situated in Phillip Street, Sydney in the State of New South Wales: And whereas in the year one thousand nine hundred and twenty-two the Federation decided to erect a building upon the said land and for that purpose employed Byera Hadley

1. This Act may be cited as the "New South Wales Short title. Public School Teachers' Federation Validating and Enabling Act, 1932."

2.
