DE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty,) by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows :---

(3) The term of office as acting member of the Hospitals Commission of New South Wales of Walter Albert Edward Lewis, Esquire, is hereby extended to and shall expire upon the thirty-first day of July, one thousand nine hundred and thirty-four.

(4) The Hospitals Act, 1929-1932, is amended by inserting at the end of subsection 5A of section six the following new paragraph:—

Where an acting chairman or an acting member vacates his office the Governor may appoint a person qualified under this section for appointment as acting chairman or acting member (as the case may be) to fill the vacant office. The appointment shall be made for the remainder of the unexpired term of the vacant office.


