Act No. 3, 1934.

An Act to modify the operation and extend the duration of the Public Service Salaries Acts, 1931-1933; and for purposes connected therewith. [Assented to, 29th June, 1934.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows :—

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Public Service Salaries (Amendment) Act, 1934." Short title.

(2) The Public Service Salaries Acts, 1931-1933, as amended by this Act may be cited as the Public Service Salaries Act, 1931-1934.

(3) This Act shall be deemed to commence on the thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and thirty-four.

Amendment of Act No. 29, 1931.

2. The Public Service Salaries Acts, 1931-1933, is amended—

Sec. 4.
(Deduction from salaries.)

(a) by inserting after subsection six of section four the following new subsection—

(7) Commencing on the first day of July, one thousand nine hundred and thirty-four the amount of the deduction to be made from the salary of an officer pursuant to the foregoing provisions of this section shall be reduced by twenty per centum.

(Duration of Act.)

(b) by omitting from section six the words "thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and thirty-four" and by inserting in lieu thereof the words "first day of July, one thousand nine hundred and thirty-five."
