 - (b) by omitting from the same paragraph the words "below two hundred and sixty-eight" and by inserting in lieu thereof the words "below two hundred and forty-one";
 - (c) by inserting in subsection two of section four after the word "widower" the words "or a divorced person" and after the word "widow" the words "or a divorced person."
