Act No. 42, 1934.

An Act to reduce the capital debt of the South Grafton Municipal Council in respect of certain works of stormwater drainage and to validate certain rates made and levied by the said Council; to amend the Local Government Act, 1919, and certain other Acts; and for purposes connected therewith. [Assented to, 11th December, 1934.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

- 1. This Act may be cited as the "South Grafton short title. Stormwater Drainage Rating Validation Act, 1934."
 - 2. In this Act—
 - "Council" means the Council of the Municipality Definition. of South Grafton.

South Grafton Stormwater Drainage Rating Validation.

Capital debt.

- 3. (1) (a) The capital debt of the council in respect of the works of stormwater drainage notified as complete in Gazette No. 104 of seventh day of September, one thousand nine hundred and twenty-three, shall be the sum of five thousand five hundred pounds.
- (b) The period for repayment of such debt shall be twenty-five years commencing from thirty-first day of December, one thousand nine hundred and thirtytwo.
- (c) The half-yearly instalments to be paid by the council in liquidation of such debt with interest at the rate of four per centum per annum on the amounts remaining unpaid shall be one hundred and seventy-five pounds and seven pence.
- (2) This section shall be deemed to have commenced on thirty-first day of December, one thousand nine hundred and thirty-two.

Application of L.G. Act, 1919.

4. The capital debt referred to in section three of this Act shall for all purposes be deemed to be a capital debt notified in accordance with the provisions of Part XIV of the Local Government Act, 1919, as amended by subsequent Acts.

Rating validation.

5. The making and levying by the council of the rate for stormwater drainage purposes of eleven-sixteenths of a penny in the pound on the unimproved capital value of land within the council's area, made and levied for the year one thousand nine hundred and thirty-three is hereby validated and such rate shall be deemed for all purposes to have been duly made and levied under the Local Government Act, 1919, as amended by subsequent Acts.
