An Act to amend the Swine Compensation Act, 1928, in certain respects; and for purposes connected therewith. [Assented to, 6th March, 1935.]

B^E it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows :--

In any prosecution or other legal proceedings under this or any other Act or under any regulations made thereunder, the record required to be kept at an abattoir in pursuance of this Act, and all entries purporting to be made therein, shall, by the production thereof alone, be prima facie evidence of the facts and matters recorded therein.
