Act No. 10, 1935.

An Act to amend the Swine Compensation Act, 1928, in certain respects; and for purposes connected therewith. [Assented to, 6th March, 1935.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Swine Compensation (Amendment) Act, 1935."
- (2) The Swine Compensation Act, 1928, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the Swine Compensation Act, 1928-1935.
- (3) This Act shall commence on the first day of March, one thousand nine hundred and thirty-five.

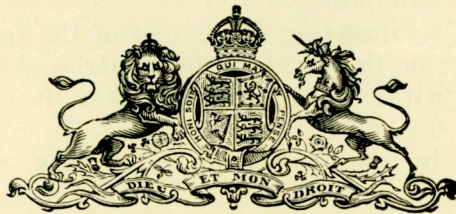
